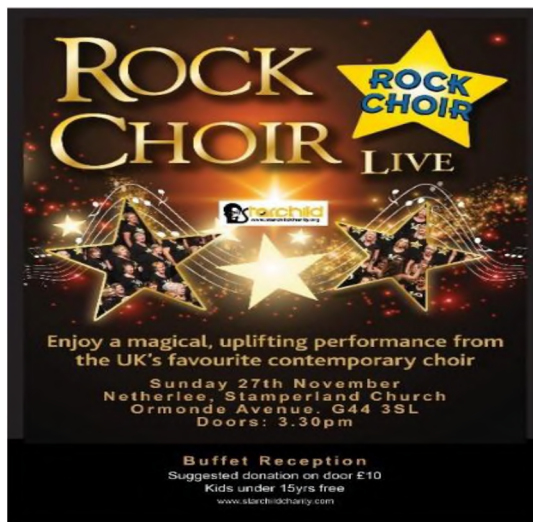
Orders being taken for Christmas cakes
